There is nothing to report at this time except the following:

After discussion with others and some consideration of the congregation's needs, it has been agreed that Wespress will revert to the quarterly format that was used in the past both by Westminster and Erskine.

Moreover it was noted that much congestion in the Narthex was caused on the 'first Sunday of the Month' communion Sundays and also in early December.

Therefore it is planned to issue future Wespresses on:

15 August – a good opportunity to advise dates and times for regular events which are starting up in September.

15 November – a good time to make known plans for the Christmas period

15 February and 15 May

All material should be provided by the 12th of the appropriate month.
